Professor Mike Gregory is the Head of the Division of Manufacturing and Management and of the Institute for Manufacturing (IfM), under the Department of Engineering, University of Cambridge.

Mike Gregory is also actively involved in other areas as follows:-

- ⇒ Advise on the quality of teaching in D-ETM and its strategic development so as to establish it as a centre of educational excellence in terms of teaching and research;
- ⇒ Advise on improvements to curriculum and teaching methodology;
- ⇒ Advise on the development and directions in undergraduate and graduate education;
- ⇒ Advise on issues such as academic governance and financing.

The 3 members will be visiting us on 3-4<sup>th</sup> July 2008 and will be visiting us once every 3 years.
