**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**On 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2008, the Division of Engineering and Technology Management at the Faculty of Engineering signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Global Management of Technology Program, Seoul National University (SNU), of Korea for a period of 5 years.**



#### **AREAS OF COOPERATION**

The Parties agree to collaborate in the following relevant areas:

- (a) to strengthen their academic and scholarly links and fruitful cooperation between the faculty of both Parties;
  - (b) the exchange of faculty members, graduate students and Ph.D candidates for short, medium or long periods of time as the case may be;
  - (c) the exchange of faculty members, graduate students and Ph.D candidates participating in joint projects as agreed to by both Parties;
  - (d) the organization of joint conferences, seminars, symposia, summer courses,
- etc;**
- (e) the exchange of publications (for which the Party who is publishing the material holds the intellectual property rights) for scholarly achievement, teaching and information purposes, in order to strengthen existing friendly relationship between the Parties.

As a start, during the special term this June, NUS and SNU are jointly offering the module MT5001 (Intellectual Property Management) via video conferencing in our “smart” classroom in Faculty of Engineering. This way, NUS and SNU students can simultaneously attend the class. This module is also open to professionals outside NUS & SNU.
