Important Notes:

1. **Students are to check with the ETM website (<http://www.eng.nus.edu.sg/etm>) again closer to the start of the semester to ensure that there are no last minute changes to any of the timings.**
2. **Classes will commence from the week of 10 August onwards. As 10 August is a public holiday, the first lesson for the modules on 10 August will commence on 17 August instead.**
3. Online module registration will commence from **3 Aug 09 9am to 23 Aug 09 11.59pm**. Please refer to the ETM website for more information, instructions and deadlines regarding the module registration.

If you cannot find an examination list listed for a particular module, it means that the module does not have any final examinations. The final grade of these courses without a final examination will be determined by other assignments and projects.

4. Students who are taking **MT5001 IP Management**, please take note that **classes will be conducted extensively twice a week on Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings. Students must be attend both lessons every week.** The last lesson will be conducted end of September, after which students will be tasked with assignments and projects that will be expected to complete by November. These will make up for the final grade in lieu of an examination paper.
5. **MT5012 Marketing of High-Technology products and Innovations** and **MT5880 Topics in Management of Technology (Techno-Economics Systems)** are new elective modules that our division is offering for the first time. You may refer to the ETM curriculum website for more details on the module.
6. Students who have taken **IE5003 Cost Analysis and Engineering Economy** or **CE5603 Engineering Economics and Project Evaluation** will not be allowed to take the module **MT5011 Finance for Engineering & Technology Management**, and vice versa.

Students who have taken **MT5006 Strategic and New Product Development** will not be allowed to take **IE5211 New Product Management**, and vice versa.

7. Students who are taking modules from NUS Business School, except BMA5115, are to prepare a 1-2 page resume for the Business School's perusal. Students must also be prepared to attend a short interview by Business School if necessary.

Students are to note that if they are admitted to take Business School modules, a fee of \$2,500 per 4MC module will be payable to NUS Business School.
